Notes

- ¹ Military records, such as the DD-214, Member-4, can be retrieved from the <u>U.S. National Archives</u> website.
- ² Veterans whose DD-214 does not indicate a home of record at time of entry into active duty or the place of entry into active duty as Texas will be required to provide a Texas high school transcript indicating their graduation within one year of their enlistment. If they entry date is more than one year after high school graduation, the Veteran will be required to provide one of the follow: lease or mortgage documentation, pay stubs, W2s, or any other documentation the school may require to verify Texas residency.
- ³ A VA Certificate of Eligibility for GI Bill Benefits is received after completing the <u>Department of Veterans Affairs online</u> <u>application for education benefits</u>. Legacy/Spouse/Child applicants will need to complete VA form 22-1990e on Vets.gov and submit confirmation page. Legacy recipients where the Veteran's DD-214 has a separation date after September 10, 2001 and prior to August 1, 2009 do not need to submit a VA Certificate of Eligibility if the type of separation is listed as "Discharge" or "Retirement" (to include those medically retired, temporary, or permanent).
