Code Alerts

CODE D - DISASTER

A Code D is usually an external disaster occurring outside the Hosptial where a large number of people are injured and require treatment and/or hospitalization. A Code D may be called as a result of an internal disaster. In a Code D, all Hospital Employees may be subject to emergency call-in. This is done utilizing management and department quick call rosters.

CODE RED - FIRE

Code Red refers to a fire and response is outlined in the Internal Disaster Plan.

CODE BLUE – CARDIO-PULMONARY RESUSCITATION EMERGENCY A patient in cardiac arrest or not breathing is identified as a code Blue. Response from appropriate departments will occur to this patient emergency.

CODE PINK – INFANT ABDUCTION

Infant being taken from the Childbirth Center. Response from all personnel will be taken to assist in the safe return of the infant.

TRAUMA CODE – ER

Trauma Code refers to a major trauma in the Emergency Room

CODE GREEN - SECURITY

Code Green is the code used when there may be violence where security is needed.

CODE SILVER - BOMB THREAT

CODE BLACK – SEVERE WEATHER
