The presidential finalists for Victoria College are listed below in alphabetical order.

Mickey D. Best, PhD, is Campus President of New Mexico State University-Grants, in Grants, New Mexico. He previously served as Vice President for Academic Affairs at South Arkansas Community College in El Dorado, Arkansas. Dr. Best earned a Doctor of Philosophy in Arts Administration from Texas Tech University in Lubbock, Texas; a Master of Fine Arts in Theatre: Directing and Performance from Texas Tech University in Lubbock, Texas; and a Bachelor of Arts in Education from Southwestern Oklahoma State University in Weatherford, Oklahoma.

James R. Dire, PhD, is President and Chancellor of Methodist College in Peoria, Illinois. He previously served as Vice Chancellor for Academic Affairs at the University of Hawaii-Kauai Community College in Lihue, Hawaii. Dr. Dire earned a Doctor of Philosophy and a Master of Arts in Earth and Planetary Science at John Hopkins University in Baltimore, Maryland; a Master of Science in Physics and Electrical Engineering from the University of Central Florida in Orlando, Florida; a Bachelor of Science in Chemistry and a Bachelor of Science in Physics and Mathematics at the University of Missouri in Kansas City, Missouri.

Robert J. Exley, PhD, is President of Snead State Community College in Boaz, Alabama. He previously served as President of Parkland College in Champaign, Illinois. Dr. Exley earned a Doctor of Philosophy in Educational Administration from The University of Texas in Austin, Texas; a Master of Arts and a Bachelor of Science in Psychology from the University of Houston-Clear Lake in Houston, Texas; and an Associate of Arts from San Jacinto College in Pasadena, Texas.

Jennifer Kent, EdD, is Senior Vice President of Ranger College in Ranger, Texas, and serves as John E. Roueche Center for Community College Leadership Cohort Coordinator/Teaching Professor at Kansas State University in Manhattan, Kansas. She previously served as Principal of Early High School in Early, Texas. Dr. Kent earned a



Doctor of Education in Educational Leadership from Texas A&M University-Kingsville, in Kingsville, Texas; a Master of Education in Educational Administration from the University of North Texas, in Denton, Texas; and a Bachelor of Arts in English from Tarleton State University in Stephenville, Texas.
