# **Regional & Institutional Overview**

Victoria College (VC), located in Victoria, Texas, is situated 50 miles inland from the Gulf of Mexico and is within a two-hour drive of Corpus Christi, Austin, San Antonio, and Houston. The city of Victoria, with a population of nearly 65,000, is the home to a wide variety of cultural arts and events that reflect the unique blend of diversity represented in the region. Established in 1925, Victoria College serves approximately 7,000 students annually in credit programs, adult education, and continuing education at the Main Campus in Victoria, an off-campus center in Gonzales, and other locations throughout the large seven-county service area. Victoria, DeWitt, Lavaca, Calhoun, Refugio, Gonzales, and Jackson counties are part of the Golden Crescent region near Texas' Gulf Coast. With a combined population of about 200,000 people and an area of approximately 6,000 square miles, major industries include oil and gas, manufacturing, agriculture, education, and medical services.

Victoria College is an established community partner with an enduring tradition of contributing to local cultural heritage and meeting the areas' employment and economic development needs. It is recognized as a Hispanic-Serving Institution and is accredited by SACSCOC. VC is a committed member of Talent Strong Texas Pathways, working to implement at full scale best practices ensuring access, completion, and transfer or workforce entry at a good wage for all students. The College is currently progressing through the Institute for Evidence-Based Change's Caring Campus program as well as journey mapping the student experience with Inside Track. The University of Houston-Victoria, a strong higher education partner, is located adjacent to VC's Main Campus and provides access to baccalaureate and graduate degrees.

A hallmark of Victoria College is exceptional dedication: employees who are committed to helping students succeed and a community that values and supports education. VC is committed to student success and being a student-centered college in which students' needs are first in the decision making.
