Academy Admission Requirements

- Complete your application to Victoria College by visiting <u>GoApplyTexas.org</u>.
- Submit the following to Admissions & Records:
 - Official high school transcripts with graduation date or GED Certificate
 - o Previous official college/university transcripts (if applicable)
 - o Bacterial Meningitis (if applicable)
 - Test Scores (see below for more information)
 - Mathematics is crucial to engineering and vital in helping engineers analyze models, predict outcomes, and make informed decisions. To ensure students can enter into their math course rotations and meet prerequisite requirements for necessary science courses, TSI completion in all subject areas (Math, ELAR, writing), or equivalent testing, is required for admission. The following options are available:
 - 1) Submit qualifying Test Scores (view the VC Catalog for required state testing).
 - 2) Schedule an appointment with the <u>Testing Center</u> to take the TSI Assessment.

Requirements within the Academy

- Dual credit students must complete 6 credit hours per semester to maintain active status within the academy.
- High school graduates must maintain full-time enrollment status while in the academy, completing 30 hours each academic year.
- Maintain a 2.5 cumulative GPA in all courses.
- Maintain a 2.5 GPA in all STEM courses.

TAMUK Guaranteed Admissions Requirements

- Satisfy all requirements previously outlined.
- 2.5 Cumulative GPA at the time of transfer.
 - 3) Complete a <u>Conquer Math, The Pirate Way</u> extended workshop. This **FREE** extended workshop:
 - is designed to equip students with the skills and confidence needed to complete their math testing requirement.
 - is a 6-week summer program that takes place Monday through Thursday from 9 a.m. to Noon.
