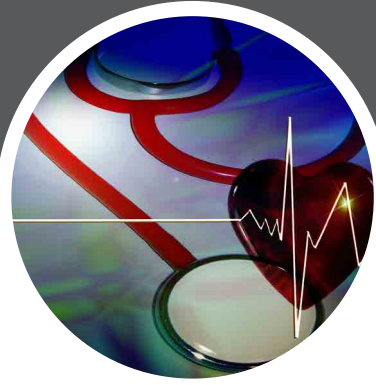

First Aid, CPR, and AED classes are non-Healthcare Provider CPR and First aid classes. Example: School teachers, athletic trainers, baby sitters, day care centers, volunteer responders, industrial and construction safety personnel, and other lay rescuers.



This course includes lecture, discussion, and skills practice following the current American Heart Association guidelines for CPR, cardiac arrest recognition, cardiac compressions, first aide, and use of Automated External Defibrillator. Pediatric Advanced Life Support

This course gives healthcare professionals the knowledge and skills to better recognize and treat critically ill infants and children. The course uses a scenario-based, team approach to teach pediatric emergency management of pediatric patients approaching or already in respiratory or cardiac arrest. Topics include Recognition and treatment of infants and children at risk for cardio-pulmonary arrest, the systematic approach to pediatric assessment, effective respiratory management, defibrillation and synchronized administration, intraosseous access and fluid bolus administration and effective resuscitation team dynamics.
