### APPLY

- Apply for admission and receive your acceptance email to Victoria College.

- Use your student ID (V#) and password to **log in to the Pirate Portal**.
- Choose **2022-23 Scholarship Application** from the Survey drop-down menu.

1. What year did you graduate (or will you graduate) from high school or complete your GED (YYYY)? Enter YEAR ONLY as YYYY.
2. Please state your current total household income. The total figures should include amounts for your parents and yourself as applicable. Enter NUMBERS ONLY, no comments please.
3. Based on a 4.0 scale, what is your current GPA?
4. What is your expected enrollment status for the upcoming academic year?
5. Please list your involvement in any organizations, public service activities, clubs, or sports and include dates of participation.
6. Why did you choose to attend Victoria College?
7. Do you plan to complete all of your education at Victoria College or will you be transferring to another institution?
8. What is your major?
9. If you are employed, who is your employer and how many hours do you work per week?
10. How would a scholarship impact your education?
11. Answer the following question using a minimum of 100 words: What are your academic or career goals and how will Victoria College help you achieve them?
12. Answer the following question using a minimum of 100 words: Describe a time in your life that has shaped who you are as a person.
13. Please select the following statement that is applicable to you.
  - I am a member of Trinity Lutheran Church, Victoria, TX.
  - I am, or someone in my immediate family is, a Rotarian.
  - I am a first generation college student.
  - These statements do not apply to me.
