

JOHNSON SYMPOSIUM TECHNICAL INFORMATION

GENERAL

The Johnson Symposium Center is a 174 seat proscenium theatre style venue. In addition, there are four dedicated spaces in the front row for wheelchair/mobility device accommodation. No additional seating is allowed, per fire code. A motorized wheelchair/mobility device lift for stage access is located on the stage right entrance.

A dedicated technical control booth is located immediately behind the seating area facing the stage. In addition, a small, ground level loading dock is located at the stage left rear of the center, providing direct stage access.

LIGHTING AND SOUND

The center features LED stage lights overhead and front of house. An ETC ION XE lighting console is located in the tech booth. A multi-channel sound console is also provided and located in the booth.

AUDIO-VISUAL SYSTEM

A Crestron system allows video presentations to be controlled from the booth. There are input panels for the system in the booth and the front of the stage. A motorized screen is located downstage right for video projection. The projector is permanently mounted above the audience and cannot be moved or adjusted.

STANDARD SET UP

The standard facility set up is as follows:

- One (1) microphone with or without lectern.
- General stage lighting wash.
- House lights.
- A/V system
