



Victoria Civilian Police Academy Alumni Association (VCPAAA)

A scholarship will be awarded to a student who has applied, has proof of college acceptance, or is currently enrolled and meets the requirements below:

- A) The student applicant is required to be a U. S. citizen, a Victoria County resident, and pursuing a degree in criminal justice, or
 - B) If the student applicant is a U. S. Citizen, the son, daughter, spouse, or employee of the Victoria Police Department, the applicant is eligible to pursue any college education/degree.
 - C) The applicant must have a minimum 3.0 grade point average to apply and include a certified transcript.
 - D) The amount of the scholarship:
 - Minimum is \$750.00
 - Maximum is \$1,000.00
- The variance is based on the number of applicants and designated funds available through the VCPAAA.
- E) The scholarship will only apply for college tuition or books; conferences or educational trips would be ineligible.

Application forms will be available in the school Guidance Office, or Victoria Police Department, located in the Public Safety Headquarters, 2525 N. Main, Victoria, TX., 77901.
