NCCER credentials ensure that craft professionals have nationally portable skills.

Carpentry Level 1-\$2,000 CRPT 1029/1001

Prerequisite: Successful completion of NCCER Core Curriculum: Introductory Craft Skills

This course provides a basic introduction into the Carpentry Trade. The course includes identification of various building materials and fasteners, estimating materials and reading blueprints. Proper use and care of hand and power tools related to Carpentry is included. Basic framing of various floor, wall, ceiling and roof layouts is covered along with installing doors, windows and building stairways. All course materials, including textbook and basic tools, provided. Students must wear safety toe boots (pull on or lace up) and long pants. 152 contact hours
