Express yourself in a relaxed and creative atmosphere! Intermediate and advanced students may pursue independent projects with instructor guidance, if desired. Some open studio time will be available to continue practicing skills and developing pieces outside of class time. Students must be 18 years or older to attend.

Ceramics is a hands-on (and sometimes messy!) process, and students are expected to help maintain a clean, shared studio environment. Workspaces and equipment should be cleaned and returned to their proper place at the end of each class.
