

## Why Transfer?

#### Factors that impact success:

- Financial Instability
- Part-Time Enrollment/Full-time Work
  - Earning more money may decrease your eligibility for financial aid
  - Part-time students are less likely to persist and graduate
- Other responsibilities
  - Children, sick parents, etc.



## How does VC help me transfer?

#### Articulation agreements

- These are agreements between community colleges and universities that guarantee your credits will transfer

## How does VC help me transfer?

#### Student Success Courses

- Taking a course like Victoria College's EDUC 1300 or SDEV 0300 (Strategies for Success/OnCourse) has shown to have a positive impact on completion and transfer rates
- <u>Discussion Questions</u>: Have you taken this course? Do you feel it helped prepare you for your college experience?

## How does VC help me transfer?

#### Accelerated Developmental Coursework

- Having to complete developmental coursework increases the amount of time spent in college
- If not completed quickly and successfully, this coursework can impact your financial aid eligibility in your junior and senior years
- Victoria College offers many opportunities for fast-track developmental math, writing and reading courses

## Ask yourself:

What is my career goal?

#### **Comparison Shop**

- Do you want to attend a private or public college?
- Do you prefer a large or small campus?
- Do you want to travel or stay close to home?



## **Comparison Shop**

- Does the college I am considering offer a good program in my major?
- Do I need to apply for my program separately from general college admissions?
- Does it offer me career counseling if I don't yet know what field to study?



#### **Comparison Shop**

- What is the reputation of the college I'm considering? How will that affect my career goals?
- How does the university handle transfers students and does it offer them financial aid?
- Will I have to retake courses when I transfer?
- Do I want to live on campus or off campus?

## 1 -2 years before you transfer

## Research degree requirements & make sure you are taking classes that transfer

 If the website is unclear, contact an advisor at the transfer institution

## Maintain good grades to ensure you will be accepted

Many higher ranked colleges will calculate your GPA using every credit (even repeated courses)

#### Less than 1 year before you transfer

## Apply to the college far in advance of the application deadline

 Be sure to complete essays, letters of recommendation, or other requirements.

## Complete your FAFSA and have results sent to your transfer institution

 If you are transferring mid-academic year (Spring) you will need to have your FAFSA information sent to the transfer institution by going online: www.fafsa.gov

Send your "in progress" transcripts to the transfer institution

## 1 Semester before you transfer

Apply for transfer scholarships (if the institution has them)

 Some colleges set scholarship deadlines earlier than application deadlines – please check the deadline early!

After your last semester has ended at VC, re-send your final transcripts to your transfer institution
