
How to apply to Victoria College





STEP 1: Visit ApplyTexas.org & Create Your Free Account




Click the "Create an Account" link below the "Log In" button.

Click on the "Start your application" link




STEP 6: Complete the Application

Once you complete this section you will review your application.




STEP 7: Review & Submit
