Introduction	<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Hook: State something unknown, clear up a misunderstanding, and show that one thing is superior to another.● Summarize the Topics: Give them some background information on the subjects● Thesis Statement: 3 topics you are going to compare
1st Paragraph of Body	<p>Support of Thesis</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">● Topic sentence: Introduces the first similarity or difference● Examples: From both text that show the similarity or difference● Explanation: Make the comparison clear● Concluding sentence: Restates the idea discussed
2nd Paragraph of Body	<p>Support of Thesis</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">● Topic sentence: Introduces the second similarity or difference● Examples: From both text that show the similarity or difference● Explanation: Make the comparison clear● Concluding sentence: Restates the idea discussed
3rd Paragraph of Body	<p>Support of Thesis</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">● Topic sentence: Introduces the third similarity or difference● Examples: From both text that show the similarity or difference● Explanation: Make the comparison clear● Concluding sentence: Restates the idea discussed
Conclusion	<p>Restatement of the thesis (in different words) or review of key points</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">● Leave the reader with a strong image or impression of the topic● How the subject relates to anyone● Reader call to action (how do you want someone to support your argument)
