Cause 2 Effect 2	<p>Support of Thesis</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">● Topic sentence (indicates causes, effects, or both)● Cause 2 (detailed explanation with examples)● effect 2 (detailed explanation with examples)● Explain the Cause and cause-and-effect relationship.● Transition to the next effect relating to this paragraph
Cause 3 Effect 3	<p>Support of Thesis</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">● Topic sentence (indicates causes, effects, or both)● Cause 3 (detailed explanation with examples)● effect 3 (detailed explanation with examples)● Explain the Cause and cause-and-effect relationship.● Transition to the next effect relating to this paragraph.
Antithesis	<p>Discuss the opposing side of the argument.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">● What happens if we don't prevent the effects?● This paragraph will discuss the other side of the issue by identifying the major causes and effects. Also, explain the causes behind choosing a topic and how it will be relevant to modern life. This way, you can show the logic behind the occurrence of the two variables and their possible causes and effects.
Conclusion	<p>Restatement of the thesis (in different words) or review of key points</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">● Restate your thesis statement and bring the logical lines of your examples together.● Call to Action, can you suggest a solution?
